Here are some sample questions you might ask each other in a small accountability group. Your group can add to or adjust these questions.

Have I been a verbal testimony to Christ?

Have I spent adequate time in prayer and reading God's Word?

Have I seen any sexually explicit material that will damage my relationship with my husband or Christ?

Have I spent money recklessly? Have I demonstrated good stewardship?

Have I intentionally honored my husband and children?

Have I damaged another with my words?

Have I given in to an addiction in my life?

Have I remained angry toward another?

Have I wished misfortune or hardship on anyone?

Have I been totally honest today?

Have I allowed any person or circumstance to rob me of my joy?
